Collaboration

- Active collaboration
 - AMCH, Ellis (ABHC), AHI are jointly collaborating in an IT 'TOM' project
 - This project will hopefully move our IT forward for two of the most challenging projects
 - Also will give us a head start on other IT issues and projects

Implementation plan process

- Implementation plan template was released – required sections will be developed that were not in Project Plan
- Surveys gathered key information
 - Response rate ~31%
 - Information used to identify and address key risks to implementation
- Surveys still can be submitted

Implementation plan process

- Key stakeholder meetings provided information and commitments regarding participation in projects
- Specific plan details will be shared and approved by the Executive Committee
- AMCH Project Management Office is laying out a timeline for milestones

Implementation Plan Approval

- The full plan will be presented for PAC review prior to the May 1 submission date
